The proposed work may include but is not necessarily limited to: Removing old crack sealant where it has failed and is revealing <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" width and 3" depth crevasses, prior to applying new sealant. Some areas on the runway have been identified for block patching. These particular block patching areas are where existing block patches have failed or have seam separation.

Bid security shall be made payable to the Town of Haverhill. Late bids, unsigned bids, facsimile bids, electronic, or bids submitted without security will not be considered.

The successful bidder must provide a 100 percent Performance Bond, and a 100 percent Labor and Materials Payment Bond, and begin execution of this contract within five (5) calendar days following the Notice to Proceed.

Construction under this contract will be funded by Federal Grant under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) and will be subject to all applicable requirements of the U.S. Department of Transportation / Federal Aviation Administration and the New Hampshire Department of Transportation. Award of all contracts will be contingent upon receipt of Federal funding under the AIP.

Wages paid to employees must comply with the minimum established by U.S. Department of labor Wage Determination and CH 149, § 26-27D, M.G.L. The contractor must comply with the Davis-Bacon Act, Anti-Kickback Act, the Occupational Safety and Health Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standard Act, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Executive Order 11246.
