This Addendum forms part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Bidding Documents dated April 07, 2022. **NOTE: Contractor to Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on Page 1 of the Bid Form (Section 00410, Page 00\410-1). Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to disqualification.**

I. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS (SPECIFICATIONS) CHANGES

- A. PARAGRAPH SIX (6) OF SECTION OF SECTION C-111 SHALL BE REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING:
 - a. The anticipated project schedule is to start construction on or about October 17th, 2022, to allow for tree clearing, grubbing and any other desired initial work, and complete construction by September 15, 2023. Two hundred ten (210) days will be allowed to complete all work, in accordance with the contractor's schedule. See Section 00850 Special Conditions on additional construction schedule requirements.
- B. SECTION 4.02(A) OF C-520 (AGREEMENT) SHALL BE REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING:
 - a. The Work will be substantially completed within 180 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run as provided in Paragraph 4.01 of the General Conditions, and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions within 210 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run.
- C. SECTION 00850 SPECIAL CONDITIONS SECTION 1.02.B SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING:
 - a. Two hundred ten (210) days is allowed to complete the work, with all work being completed by September 15, 2023.
- D. SECTION 00850 SPECIAL CONDITIONS SECTION 1.02.D SHALL BE REMOVED.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the Construction of the South Main Street and Mason Road Pedestrian Improvements will be received by the Town of Brookline, at the Town Hall, 1 Main Street, Brookline, NH 03033, until **2:00 PM** local time on, **September 12, 2022**. Bids received will be publicly opened and read at **6:30 PM** that evening at a Special Selectboard meeting at the Town Hall.

The proposed project will construct two segments of new sidewalk infrastructure in Brookline, NH. The first segment, along South Main Street, will extend southerly from the Main Street intersection approximately 2,050 feet, terminating in the vicinity of 20 South Main Street. The second segment along Mason Road will extend easterly from the Potanipo Hill Road intersection 210 feet to the access driveway to the state boat ramp.

Work shall include, but is not limited to, construction of two prefabricated steel truss pedestrian bridge superstructures, construction of concrete substructures (concrete abutments and wingwalls), construction of bituminous concrete sidewalks and concrete ADA tip-downs, installation of some granite curbing, wood railing fence installation, and guardrail installation. The work shall also include pedestrian detour, traffic maintenance (alternating one-way traffic control), earthwork, tree clearing, signs, striping, drainage, and minor items ancillary to roadway work.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

The Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost is between \$1,000,000.00 and \$1,500,000.00.

The anticipated project schedule is to start construction on or about October 17, 2022, to allow for tree clearing, grubbing and any other desired initial work, and complete construction **by September 15, 2023**. **Two hundred ten (210) days will be allowed to complete all work, in accordance with the contractor's schedule. See Section 00850 Special Conditions on additional construction schedule requirements.**
