The Project includes the following Work:

Installation of an access road, grass-lined swale, terraced gravel wetland with associated drainage structures in the Williston Town Fields (located south of the Williston Town Offices and north of I-89).

Town Fields Stormwater FRP System in Williston, VT

Owner anticipates that the Project's total bid price will be approximately between \$250,000 and \$500,000. The Project is expected to be substantially completed by August 31, 2026.
